Mandated by the state, NO Parent will be permitted entry into the facility while children are present.



## DROP OFF AND PICK UP:

- New drop off//pick up location for LAS: Cator Avenue side door thru parking lot.
- Please arrive as close to your drop off time as possible to prevent traffic jams and overcrowding of families.
- Campers will not be accepted early and if you are late your camper will not be permitted entry until we have completed morning check in procedures.
- Do Not exit your vehicle until your Counselor enters the pick zone.
- If you are walking, please stand on designated spaces to allow social distancing.
- Counselor will call names. Do not approach the drop off zone until your child's name is called.
- Please have your child wear their backpacks if possible, to reduce the need for parent/Counselor contact.
- No early drop off or late pickup during summer camp. We will reconsider adding those hours back in for the 2020-2021 camp year on a case by case basis. Campers are not permitted to mix with cheer teams which is not possible to accomplish with late pick up.
- Do not attempt morning or afternoon conversations in person with your child's Counselor.
- If you need to communicate utilize band, email, or set up a time for phone calls.

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## Please abide by social distancing guidelines as provided by Governor Murphy



- All children will be temperature checked upon arrival.
- Do not send your child to school sick as they will be denied entry. Do not use pain reliever in the morning to mask symptoms. If symptoms develop throughout the day, pickup is immediate and the child will not be permitted back to our facility for three full school days fever and symptom free.
- Hands will be washed with soap and water immediately after they enter the building.
- Children are not required to wear masks throughout the day when with their designated group.
- Since masks are recommended for children 2 and older, if you wish for your child to wear a mask please provide one.
- All staff will be required to wear masks.
- Please send disposable food and drinks eachday. Treat everyday as a field trip!
- We will not refill cups or wash utensils. Everything will be thrown out. Exceptions made in the infant room.
